Rian graduated from Sacramento State in 2007 with a BA in Child Development and a minor in Social Work. He began his journey in the expanded learning field in October 2007, working for a local nonprofit agency in South Sacramento as an after-school instructor to 5th-grade students for 3 1/2 years. In 2011, he became a program manager. Shortly after, he was promoted to coordinator, launched the agency's first site in the Elk Grove Unified School District, and oversaw multiple school sites. In the next seven years, he built out the EGUSD programs from one site to 15 sites, serving over 3,000 students and supervising nearly 200 full-time and part-time employees. In November 2022, he transitioned to the Washington Unified School District as the Coordinator of Expanded Learning Programs, overseeing the 7 TK-8th grade sites and working with the three community-based organizations.
