ASES and 21st CCLC Attendance Tracking
From California Department of Education

After School Education and Safety (ASES) programs and **21st Century Community Learning Centers (21st CCLC)** will both be reviewed to ensure grantees/sites are reaching at least **85-100% of targeted attendance**. California Department of Education (CDE) clarified that **all funding** – before-school base, after-school base as well as before/after school supplemental – **must meet targets or will be subject to grant reductions**. All programs must meet at least 85% target minimum to remain fully funded.

Base Funding

In the past, CDE was primarily reviewing core grants. Please note: **If a base grant is reduced, supplemental funding is also subject to reduction.**

Supplemental grants

Supplemental grants cannot exceed 30% of the core grant amount. **Supplemental grants will also be reviewed independently** to ensure the 85% minimum target is reached.

Dual-funded sites must hit their targets for both grants.

ASES must be at 100%, and 21st CCLC must be at least 85% of target for full funding to remain intact. This is regardless of whether or not a district or a CBO holds the grant for the same site(s). CDE holds the LEA ultimately responsible, regardless of

who technically is the grantee. ASES takes priority, and must reach 100% attendance before any 21st CCLC funding may be spent (if not, the federal government considers this to be supplanting).
